Editor's Report - Board meeting 22 Jun 2022

19 June 2022

1. July-August Editions: As of today, the online editions have been posted. The print edition is scheduled to go into the mail on Tuesday, June 21 - after Monday's holiday. The E-Dition should go out next week.

The July-August online edition has an extensive section on Spring Conference. The print edition has shorter sections on SC.

I appreciate the help of Russell (Mort) Mortenson, for getting the photos for the Blacksmiths of Sonoma County to me.

Speaking of photos, I received about 2000 photos from Spring Conference.

- **2. Expanded Print Edition**. With CBA leadership's concurrence, we have expanded the page count for the July-August print edition to 16 inside pages. This will give us a firm grasp on the affordability of expanding the print magazine.
- <u>3. Print/Online</u>. I'm continuing to play with this mix and structure. Recently I've gotten subscription access to the Los Angeles Times online I think they are close to having this structure and design figured out. For both the LA Times and the Wall Street Journal, the subscription cost for online-only is nearly the same as print + online.

4. Hephaistos. I've been working with the editor of Hephaistos, to co-publish articles. We had intended for the Patrick Beck book review to be simultaneously published, but then the book publisher told us to wait for a German-language translation that is due out.

We expect to have an article in the July edition of Hephaistos about our 2022 Spring Conference.

- <u>5. September-October Edition</u>: I've started working on this. I have two possible focus areas, and am still undecided as to which to pick. I'll have to make that decision in the next few days.
- **<u>6. Reprints:</u>** So far this year, we've had 27 articles reprinted in other newsletters.
- <u>7. New Articles:</u> I'm considering a new series, The Afternoon Blacksmith. This would be projects which a Level 1 student could likely complete in an afternoon. I'm thinking of using the projects taught at our teaching forges as examples.

As always, I would appreciate help finding articles. If you know of something that would make a good article, let me know so that I can chase it down.

I would like to do some bladesmithing and chasing/repousse articles, but need help finding sources/authors for these.

I do need help getting screenshots from the online events. Those of you who participate, please grab a few representative shots and forward, so that we can show that CBA is doing things. And show our members participating.

8. Website: I think everything but the home page is up to date. Photos from Spring Conference have been posted on the home page.
