CBA Scholarship Application

A CBA Scholarship provides support for attending a class at an established Blacksmithing or Crafts school. For a scholarship, CBA generally pays the school directly. If you have paid fees to the school before CBA funds the scholarship, you will usually be able to get these funds returned by the school up to the dollar amount of the CBA funding. Note that CBA Scholarships are not free money, we expect you to pay it forward by teaching some of what you learned to the CBA membership either at an event or by writing a focused how-to article.
