

## **Camping at CBA Spring Conference 2022 in Petaluma**

Camping is available at Spring conference with a fee of \$15 / day per vehicle for car or tent camping and \$35 per day for RV Camping with water and electrical hook-up. (No sewer hook-up.) The per vehicle fee is due for all overnight parking.

Be good stewards of the Fairgrounds property, damage to Fairground's property is prohibited including damage to the grass in camping areas.

Parallel Park along Gness Concourse and in other paved areas of the fairgrounds but don't park in areas reserved for RV'ers with hook-ups, areas reserved for Food Trucks or areas for conference or fairgrounds staff. **No parking on the grass.** Depending in the turf conditions and how recently it has rained, Fairgrounds staff might permit some vehicle access to the camping areas for the purpose of set-up and loading. If so, that will be clearly posted but a "go slow" speed limit of 5 MPH must be observed.

Parking inside the fairgrounds is limited and we request that you use the Park'n'Ride lot adjacent to the fairgrounds main gate at Washington St./Payran St. Just North of Sonoma-Marin Fairgrounds and East of Sonoma County Regional Library. Note that overnight parking is not permitted there. Overnight parking within the Fairgrounds is a privilege only available with the camping/parking fee.

Restroom facilities with showers are available adjacent to the camping space.

Clean up after yourself. Leave the campground and parking in better shape than you found them. CBA will be paying for dumpster service but it is up to everyone to make sure that all the trash gets into the dumpster. Also, just like Oktoberfest, if you can, take home some trash.

No open fires in the campground areas. Fire is permitted in portable barbeque units and portable fire pits that protect the underlying surface.

No firearms or other weapons on the fairgrounds.

All animals must remain on a leash and not be allowed to run loose. Owners of vicious, dangerous, or excessively noisy animals may be required to leave.

Alcoholic beverages and/or legal drugs may only be consumed in the camping areas and never in the demonstration or education areas. These substances must not be provided to minors.

No smoking within 20 feet of any tent, RV, or building that is not your own. Cigarette butts are trash that must be packed out.

We'll all have a great time, especially if you behave as you'd want others to behave.
